Not only border them on a variety of lessons that can decrease students' creativity. A teacher should affect students in all spheres of learning, either in the form of presentations, in question with answer, discussion, or other [2].

Secondly, teachers as motivators. Teachers give motivation and spirit to their students that can build confidence from the students. In this way a teacher as did not give a punishment if their student made other types of exercise. Nevertheless, the teacher will not finish continuing to support and motivating students in order to

repair the mistake and build self-motivate them. Teachers should always be constructive to adopt innovative new methods to motivate students to learn the children by placing their students as a center of learning, meaning the extent to which the material presented is depends on the teacher and the curriculum but it depends on the students. Third role of teachers as inspiration. They are not only a student assistant in the classroom, but also plays as a friend who can provide inspiration to their students. In every situation, teachers have the most important in building strong character in their students as a teacher trying to construct therefore students thought the teacher should be an inspiration that can be an inspiration for others.

As teachers, they should do those 3 points, because if the teaches were too dominate in class, it can cause the students' participation became more passive. In this case, the teachers' role are just connector or facilitator (including as motivator and an inspiration). It can be an effective way to teach the students become more creative and this condition makes the students more active and communicative[2].

Therefore, if the teachers can combine those points, it can make a better future for the students, because:

- teachers as facilitator distribute the material of the lesson.
- Teachers as motivator can give a positive input for the students' development.
- Teacher as inspiration can give an experience for the students to more and more gain. Let us here we will connect all those points with a lexical approach to language learning. According to current views on language teaching (learning, vocabulary knowledge is central to language skills whether the language is first, second or foreign.

However, as nation claims, learning of vocabulary form meaning-focused input is most effective if learners are familiar with at least 95% of words in the input they are focusing on. Lewis (97) says, "Language consists not of traditional grammar and vocabulary but often of multi-word prefabricated chunks". These chunks are lexical phrases, collocations, idioms, fixed and semi-fixed phrases which from an important part of the language [1].

Solving such kind of "puzzles" is a very attractive activity for revising vocabulary in which students are given the meaning of medical words and their task is to provide these words. To conclude, the teaching of specialist vocabulary is an essential part of ESP and EAP courses.

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
